Terms and deadlines:

The papers will be written in English, B5 format, as the model (see document: Model Paper Doctoral Symposium Oradea) and will have exactly 4 pages. Power point presentations of the paper will be done in English, within 10-15 minutes/paper. Accepted papers will be published, after the review, in a volume with an ISBN / ISSN code, published by the University of Oradea.

The full paper (4 pages), including title and authors' names, contact and affiliation will be sent by email to sesiunedrdec@gmail.com until 8th of November, 2019.

There will be accepted for publication only the papers submitted strictly within the deadline, that fully comply with the requirements of formatting, in Economics and related area (Business Administration / Economic / Social Sciences) and meet the scientific requirements of such events.

All papers will be reviewed by members of the Scientific Committee. The papers which do not fully comply to the formatting rules will be automatically rejected, before the reviewing process.

The notification of acceptance / rejection of paper will be sent by email to the contact author until 20th of November, 2019. Publication of the papers in the Conference Proceedings will be done after the session, by the end of 2019.

The Ph.D. students may submit a maximum of two papers, either as sole author or with their Ph.D. coordinator, or with another Ph.D. student(s). There will be also admitted papers authored by post-doctoral students and young researchers.

Publishing opportunities:

The conference paper (4 pages) will be published free of charge in the conference volume (Emerging Markets Economics and Business. Contributions of Young Researchers. Proceedings of the 10th International Conference of Doctoral Students and Young Researchers).

Additionally, all authors could submit extended versions of their papers, with different title (between 8 and 10 pages, according to the journal's requirements), to be published in "The Annals of the University of Oradea. Economic Sciences" – Issue of December 2018, journal indexed in: multiple international databases: <http://anale.steconomiceuoradea.ro/>. The extended papers will have to meet the journal's own criteria and they will pass through standard reviewing process. The extended papers are to be sent until 1st of December 2019.

A limited number of authors will be invited to publish an extended version of their papers, with different title (between 8 and 10 pages), free of charge, in "Oradea Journal of Business and Economics" – OJBE – Issue of March 2020, journal indexed in multiple international databases: <http://ojbe.steconomiceuoradea.ro/>.

Fees and payment:

There is no fee for participation in the conference and publication in the Conference Proceedings. Eventual travel expenses, accommodation and meals will be borne by the participants.

For publication of the extended version of the paper in Oradea Journal of Business and Economics - OJBE there is no fee. For publication of the extended version of the paper in The Annals of the University of Oradea. Economic Sciences, the submission fee is 150 Romanian lei or 35 EUR.
